The 7th Constitution Day and the National Day of Nepal was observed at the Embassy of Nepal, Beijing.

H.E. Mr Mahendra Bahadur Pandey, Ambassador of Nepal to the People's Republic of China hoisted the flag amid the ceremony held at the Embassy of Nepal in Beijing on the 19th September. Madam Bhimu Kumari Thapa, diplomatic officials of the Nepal Embassy and their family members were present in the ceremony.

Later, on the 20th September, the Embassy hosted a reception at the Lumbini Hall, Embassy of Nepal.

The reception commenced with the National Anthem of Nepal and the People's Republic of China. The National Day Messages of the Rt Hon'ble President Mrs Bidya Devi Bhandari and Rt Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Sher Bahadur Deuba were read aloud.

While addressing the ceremony, H.E. Mr Mahendra Bahadur Pandey underscored the significance of the National Day as the day of the promulgation of the Constitution of Nepal by the Constituent Assembly; and its promises to fulfill the collective aspirations for perpetual peace, good governance, development and prosperity. He also shed light on the age-old bilateral relations subsisting between Nepal and China that has been further consolidated and deepened to the mutual benefit of both nations. 'Nepal and China are not just linked by the Himalayas and rivers, but also by the hearts and minds of people that can only wish for the best for each other,' he added.

The reception witnessed the participation of the Nepali community in the People's Republic of China. In the speech, H.E. Mr Pandey commended their contribution in further bringing the peoples of two friendly neighbours even closer.
